Subject: Advisory on repatriation flights to India

To Whomsoever It May Concern

This is further to our advisory dated October 05, 2020, regarding repatriation flight being arranged by Kerala Samajam, Indonesia. The proposed flight on November 10, 2020 is on schedule.

2. The India Club, Jakarta has informed that they are in the process of gathering information from stranded Indians/interested persons to assess the viability of arranging a chartered flight for the sectors *Jakarta - Delhi - Jakarta tentatively on November 30*, *2020. It will return to Jakarta on the same day*. Interested persons are advised to visit the following websites for more details:

3. The Embassy would facilitate the process of flight clearance once all the particulars are finalized.

4. The Embassy is not engaged with any other organisations or persons for any chartered flight at the moment

Indian nationals and OCI card holders who need to visit India for emergency or pressing reasons are advised to follow Embassy website and Embassy social media handles for information regarding future repatriation flights to India from Indonesia. People are advised to exercise due caution with regard to sharing their personal particulars with any agency that claims to be organising charter flights without having the No Objection Certificate from Government.
