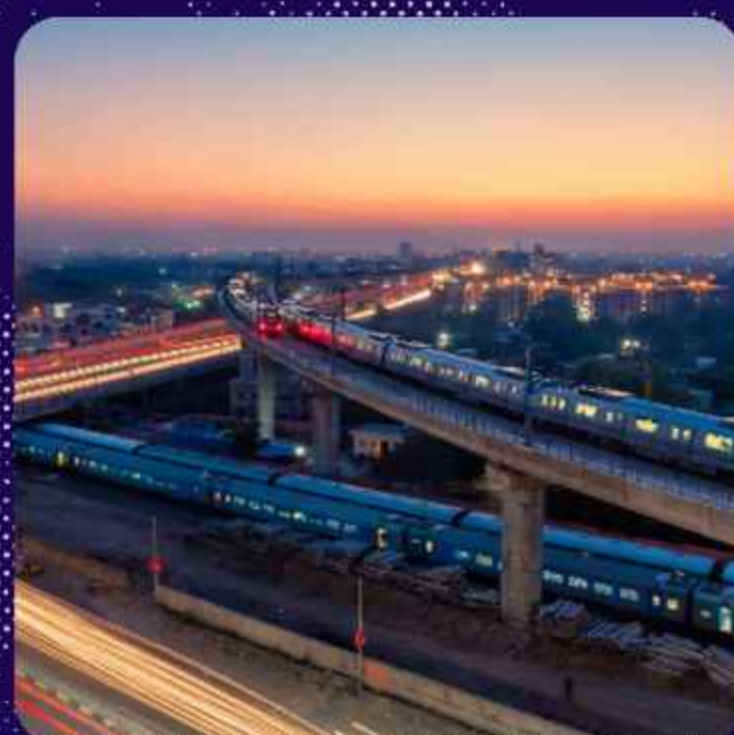

- ➔ Bilateral ties elevated to Comprehensive Strategic Partnership in May 2018
- ➔ President Sukarno, the first President of Indonesia, was the Chief Guest for India's 1st Republic Day in 1950

NEW INDIA

- ➡ The world's fifth-largest economy by nominal GDP
- ➡ Contributes around 3.37% of the world's GDP
- ➡ Democracy in India is the largest by population in the world
- ➡ World youngest populations: 65 per cent of the country is under the age of 35
- ➡ In 2023, India became the first country to land on the coveted lunar south pole, and in January 2024, it became the first Asian country to successfully place a probe in the sun's orbit
- ➡ The country's rail network is being modernized and expanded, while its road network is the second longest in the world

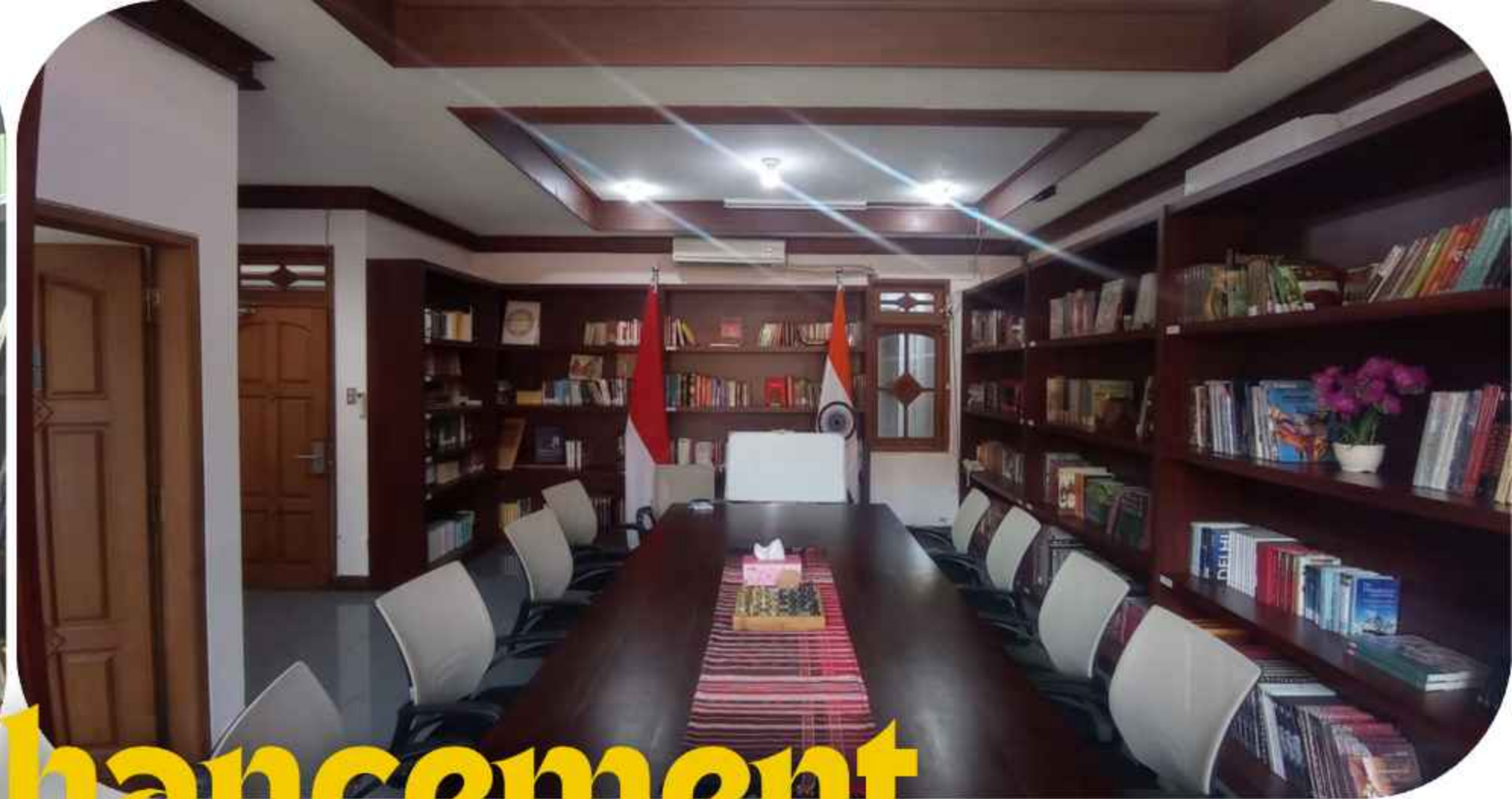

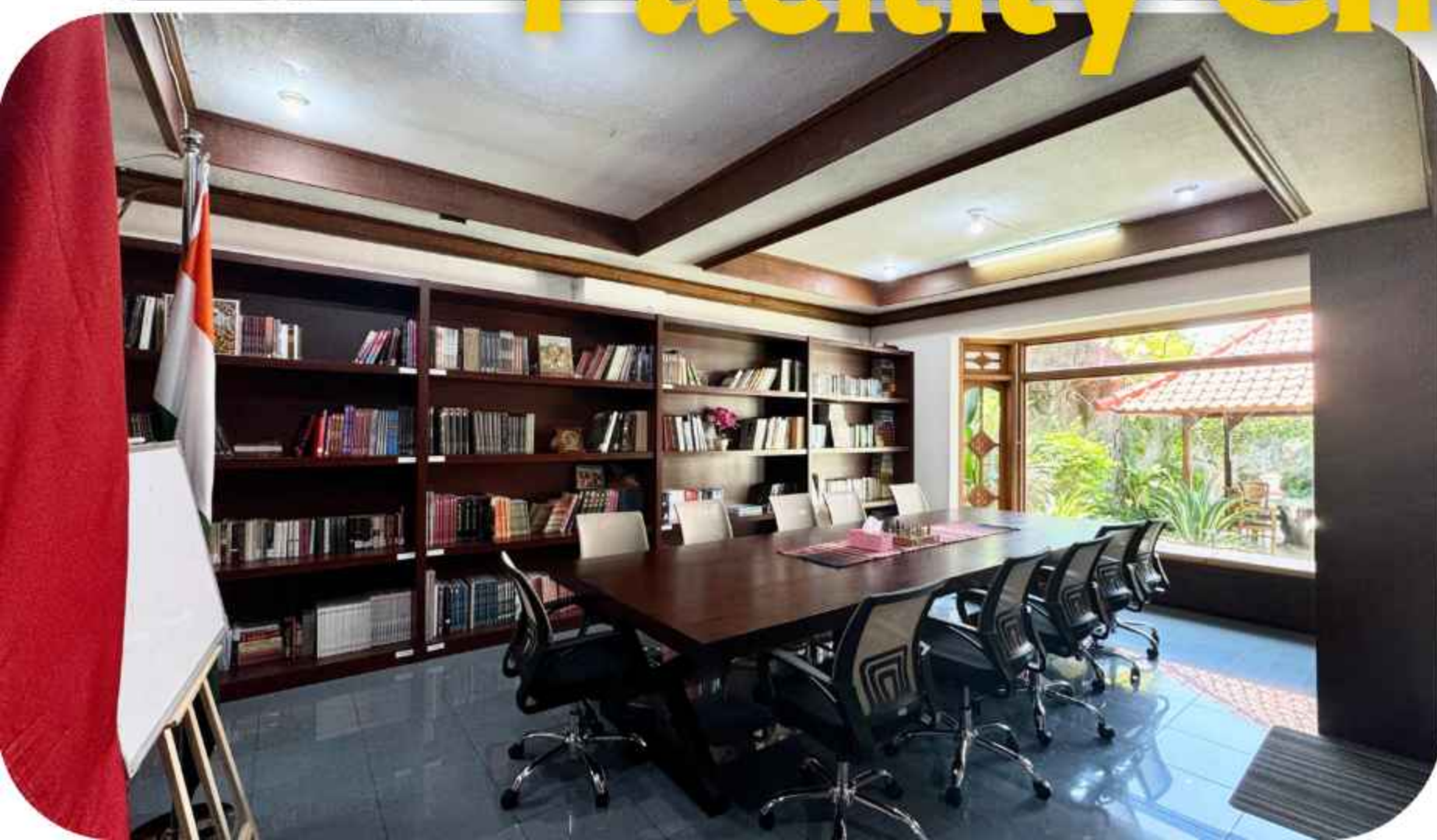
